## Introduction

### 1. eBay Accounts

- If you already have a seller eBay account, please use it.  
If no, please create it on [www.ebay.com](http://www.ebay.com).
- For the correct work of our eConnector, we also require eBay Developer Account.  
If you already have it, please take the data from it.  
If no, please create an eBay Developer Account following the steps below:

1. To create an eBay Developer Account, please follow this link:

2. In the opened window, click the **Join Now** button...

... and fill in the form with your personal data. Please mind the autosuggest at the end of every field to enter the data correctly.

**Note!** For the purpose of convenience, we suggest that eBay Developer and Seller accounts have the same logins and passwords.

## 5. Getting API Access to PayPal

eBay also requires the following data from the seller's PayPal:

- API username and password
- PayPal email
- Signature or API Certificate

To take this data, please do the following:

1. Sign in to your PayPal account at [www.paypal.com](http://www.paypal.com).
2. Click *My Account* tab and then on *Profile > My Selling Preferences*.
3. In the opened window, click the *API Access* link.

### Setting up API permissions and credentials
